

Worth guitarist, singer, composer and producer with a resume that included Kristofferson, Raitt and Dylan. The band has had a steady lineup of Austin dignitaries since its induction. The current incantation consists of some real heavyweights: Bruce Hughes (Bob Snider, Montv Montgomery), Scrappy Judd Newcomb (Loose Diamonds, Toni Price, Troy Campbell), Miles Zuniga (Fastball) and Jeff Plankenhorn (Joe Ely, Willis Alan Ramsey, Ruthie Foster, Eliza Gilkyson, Slaid Cleaves, Bruce Robison, Susan Gibson). The place was packed and the show was classic Austin hip. I'm not sure I'm cool enough for Austin anymore. I used to be right in the middle of this scene but that's been a long time. They played all originals as far as I could tell and traded the spotlight back and forth, dropping names and exuding buckets of cool. We listened to a half dozen songs and bolted.


