They play the *Porch* 3-4 times every year and always finish off the season with this fan appreciation weekend. The fans, affectionately known as Storm Chasers, follow the band to Port A each October and throw down one heck of a party. There was a real magic about the show this year. I've never heard the band sound better. This was Higgins' Facebook post the next day, "Man...last night was, without a doubt, one of THE best nights of playing music with the band (ever). 
